- POTTERY: No machine made work is accepted.
- PAPER: Handmade paper and books
- FIBER and TEXTILES: Work of primarily fiber including quilts, crochet, knitted items, clothing and painted fabric.
- GLASS: Work in which the primary material is glass. No manufactured molds or other forms of mass production allowed.
- JEWELRY: Made from precious and non-precious metals, gem-stones, enamel, glass, clay, fiber, etc. Absolutely no resell or manufactured jewelry.
- LEATHER: Decorative work or articles made from leather.
- METAL: Functional, non-sculptural metal work.
- PRINTMAKING: Prints made by woodcuts, silk-screening, etching and intaglio.
- WOOD: Turned or carved.
- CONSUMABLE HOUSEHOLD GOODS: Brooms, candles, other household items of use.
- MEDICINAL & BODY: Soaps, body products, medicinal herbs.
- HERITAGE FOODS: Breads, jams, jellies, and packaged or whole other foods.
